



With regards to the evil found in the *makhlooqaat*, Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al 'Uthaymeen *rahimahullaah* states:

It is not the case that everything which Allaah has created contains evil. However you seek refuge from its evil if it does contain evil because the *makhlooqaat* of Allaah (those things which Allaah has created) are divided into three categories:

1) purely evil – such as the Fire and Iblees, with regards to their very essence. However with regards to the wise purpose for which Allaah created these two, then it is good.

2) purely good – such as Paradise, and the Messengers and the Angels

3) (those things) that contain evil and good – such as mankind and the jinn and the animals .

And you only seek refuge from the evil of that which contains evil.
