

What is the meaning of "strong" believer?

With regards to the believer who is "strong" Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al 'Uthaymeen rahimahullaah states:

And the intent behind the statement of the Prophet sall Allaahu 'alaihi wa sallam

"The strong believer is better and more beloved to Allaah than the weak believer"

- is not muscular strength. Rather the intent is the believer strong in his *eemaan* and not (necessarily) in his body. For how many a person there is who is strong in his body but there is no goodness in him – and vice versa?

And connected to this, is that were you to write the phrase

"The strong believer is better and more beloved to Allaah than the weak believer"

upon a large board above a playing area where exercise is done – based on the meaning of a strong believer who has muscular strength –then this is not permissible.
